## Calcium, 24 Hrs Urine

### Clinical Significance:

"Increased urinary calcium excretion (hypercalciuria) is associated with kidney stone disease and osteoporosis. Other causes of hypercalciuria include hyperparathyroidism, Paget disease, prolonged immobilization, vitamin D intoxication, and diseases that destroy bone (such as metastatic cancer or multiple myeloma). Urine calcium excretion is also used to assess the adequacy of calcium and vitamin D supplementation."
