*Sample: Urine*

**Specimen** Urine

**Method** Dark field microscopy

**Microscopy Result** : Leptospira species not seen in dark field microscopy.

**Biological reference interval** : Leptospira spp not seen

**Indication:** As an aid in diagnosis of Leptospirosis by qualitative detection of leptospira in Blood specimens.

**Interpretation:** Presence of leptospira in blood indicates recent infection. Leptospira species not seen in blood examination however does not rule out infection. Additional testing such as Leptospira IgM & IgG, Leptospira PCR depending upon the stage of the illness is recommended. Clinical correlation of the results is recommended.

**Limitation:** Leptospirae are present in blood during the first ten days of illness in an untreated individual
