Clinical Significance

- 1. HIV-1 RNA (viral load) is a surrogate marker for HIV-1 disease progression and response to antiretre treatment (ART).
- 2. HIV-1 RNA assays do not detect HIV-2 viral load
- 3. Viral load is not a useful prognostic indicator nor does it measure the severity of viral disease.
- 4. The measurement can only help us guide to initiate or monitor treatment response.
- 5. A single HIV-1 viral load test result should not be used as the sole criterion in guiding therapeutic decis and intervention in the clinical care of HIV-1 infected patients. +/-0.5 difference of log 10 value m

- 7. Note: Viral load test results may vary from lab to lab.
- 8. Therefore, it is advisable to have the viral load tests done at the same laboratory each time during treatmen monitoring so that the results are comparable.
