Hepatitis E Virus IgG Antibodies

Method : ELFA


Interpretation:

Negative	< cutoff	Presumed negative for immunity/past infection with Hepatitis E.
Positive	>cutoff	Indicates, either past infection with Hepatitis E or immunity due to vaccination.

Clinical Significance:

- Anti HEV IgG antibodies may be present in individuals who have received blood products within the past several months, but who have not been immunized or earlier infected.
- Positive results should be correlated with the patient's clinical history and epidemiologic exposure.
- Regardless of exposure history, testing for anti hepatitis E virus IgG alone is insufficient to detect acute hepatitis E.
- In addition to testing for Anti HEV IgM class antibodies should be performed to detect acute hepatitis E.
