Rapid Filaria Antigen Detection

Interpretation

1. Positive results are seen in parasitic disease of human lymph system caused by Wuchereria bancrofti (W. bancrofti) leading to conditions like lymphedema, hydrocele and disfiguring disease of elephantiasis.
2. Negative results are seen in absence of W. bancrofti infection. However, it does not rule out the disease.
3. Results should be co-related with clinical condition and tests like thick smear microscopy and membrane filtration test.
4. False positive results may be due to cross reactivity with Loa loa spp or other nematodes infection.
5. False negative reaction may be due to processing of sample collected early in the course of disease or low threshold of antigen. The test should be repeated on a new specimen obtained after two weeks.

Uses •To diagnose lymphatic and non-lymphatic filariasis.

- For mapping the endemicity of lymphatic filariasis.
