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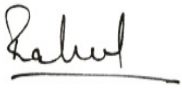

1. TB IGRA negative results cannot confirm NO *M.tuberculosis* infection. False negative results may be caused by - stage of the infection, immunodeficiency in the patient eg: patient on immunosuppressive therapy, AIDS etc.
2. Heterophile antibodies or non specific IFN- γ production from other inflammatory conditions may mask specific responses.
