Treponema Pallidium Hemagglutination

- 1. Syphilis is a chronic infection that progresses through distinct stages namely Primary, Secondary, Tertiary & Quarternary producing diverse clinical symptoms. The infection is caused by the Spirochaete *Treponema pallidum* acquired usually by sexual contact although the disease may be transmitted through blood transfusion and intrauterine infection
- 2. TPHA Test is a particle agglutination assay for the semi-quantitative detection of antibodies to *Treponema pallidum* in human serum / plasma / CSF
- 3. Positive results indicate both past or present infections.
- 4. False positive results are seen in patients suffering from Leprosy, Infectious mononucleosis and Connective tissue disorders
- 5. This test does not distinguish between Syphilis and other pathogenic treponemal infections. All positive results should be confirmed with FTA-ABS (Fluorescent Treponemal Antibodies) test.
- 6. False negative results may be seen in early primary syphilis.
