Typhidot IgM Rapid Card (Enterocheck)

Clinical Significance :

Typhidot IgM is a rapid card test used to detect enteric fever. This test is based on the presence of specific IgM antibodies to a specific antigen on S. typhi and becomes positive as early as in the first week of the fever.

Typhidot IgG & IgM, Rapid Card

Interpretation:

IgG & IgM Negative	Indicates absence of S. typhi antibodies.
IgM Positive	Indicative of current acute/ early infection with S. typhi.
IgG Positive	Indicative of previous S. typhi infection.
IgG & IgM Positive	Indicates acute typhoid fever (in the middle stage of S. typhi infection).

Clinical Significance:

This test is not a sole criterion for the diagnosis and these results should always be correlated with the clinical symptoms, and other laboratory investigations.

High titer Rheumatoid factor may result in a false positive reaction.

Cross reactivity may be observed with Salmonella paratyphi infection.
